

# UNT INTERNATIONAL TRAVEL GRANT FOR GRADUATE STUDENTS: 2023-2024

## OVERVIEW

The UNT International Travel Grant supports the professional development and global scholarship of UNT graduate students. The UNT International Travel Grant is administered by UNT International Affairs.

## ELIGIBILITY

To be considered for the UNT International Travel Grant, UNT graduate students must:

- Receive a Toulouse Graduate School Travel Grant (TGS Travel Grant) **AND**
- Present research or a creative activity at a professional meeting/venue abroad (outside of the U.S.)

## AWARD AMOUNT

- The award amount ranges from \$0 to \$500.
- The UNT International Travel Grant is awarded in the fall, spring, and summer, as funding remains available.
- All award decisions are made at the discretion of the Vice Provost and Dean of International Affairs.

## APPLICATION PROCESS

- UNT graduate students are **not required** to submit a separate application for the UNT International Travel Grant.
- UNT graduate students are **required** to indicate in their Toulouse Graduate School Travel Grant application that they would like to be considered for the UNT International Travel Grant.

## NOTIFICATION PROCESS

- UNT International Affairs will provide an award notification letter to all students who are awarded the UNT International Travel Grant.

## AWARD DISTRIBUTION

- If awarded a UNT International Travel Grant, the student's academic department or college will administer the award funding.
