

UNT INTERNATIONAL TRAVEL GRANT FOR GRADUATE STUDENTS: 2025-2026

OVERVIEW

The UNT International Travel Grant supports the professional development and global scholarship of UNT graduate students. The UNT International Travel Grant is administered by UNT International Affairs.

ELIGIBILITY

To be considered for the UNT International Travel Grant, UNT graduate students must:

- Receive a Graduate Student Travel Award (<https://tgs.unt.edu/new-current-students/graduate-student-travel-award.html>) **AND**
- Present research or a creative activity at a professional meeting/venue abroad (outside of the U.S.)

AWARD AMOUNT

- The award amount ranges from \$0 to \$500.
- The UNT International Travel Grant is awarded in the fall, spring, and summer, as funding remains available.
- All award decisions are made at the discretion of the Vice Provost of International Affairs.

APPLICATION PROCESS

- UNT graduate students are **not required** to submit a separate application for the UNT International Travel Grant.
- UNT graduate students are **required** to indicate in their Graduate Student Travel Award application that they would like to be considered for the UNT International Travel Grant.

NOTIFICATION PROCESS

- UNT International Affairs will provide an award notification letter to all students who are awarded the UNT International Travel Grant.

AWARD DISTRIBUTION

- If awarded a UNT International Travel Grant, the student's academic department or college will administer the award funding.
